## THIS WEEK'S HIGHLIGHT

### Gideons International

*All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, — 2 Timothy 3:16*

In 1899, Samuel E. Hill and John H. Nicholson, Christian businessmen who first met each other while travelling on business, founded the Gideons. These men were committed to find a way for Christian commercial travelers to get together for mutual recognition, personal evangelism, and united service for the Lord. The two men drew just one more businessman to their first meeting, but they persisted. By faith, they established the oldest organization of its kind, now with more than 270,000 members in 200 countries around the world.

All Christian business and professional men and their wives who are dedicated to telling people about Jesus are eligible to be Gideons. They share their faith personally as God provides openings. They provide Bibles and New Testaments wherever they are welcomed. While they are known worldwide for their work placing Bibles in hotel rooms, the Gideons also share Scriptures in schools and colleges, prisons and jails, hospitals, and medical offices.

Every six days, an average of one million Scriptures in 90 languages are distributed worldwide in nearly 200 countries. This totals more than two billion Bibles and New Testaments in circulation today. With the support of congregations like ours, the Gideons are able to give a New Testament or Bible to anyone who asks.
