THIS WEEK'S HIGHLIGHT The Gospel of Grace and Glory

Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. Through him we have also obtained access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and we rejoice in hope of the glory of God. — Romans 5:1-2

500 years ago, a bold Augustinian friar named Martin Luther posted a message in Latin for his superiors. Titled "Disputation on the Power and Efficacy of Indulgences," the message was quickly distributed throughout Europe.

What kind of message could have made such an impact? The one that changed human history — the incredible truth that God gives His children what they cannot earn, do not merit, and have no way to purchase: eternal life. Martin Luther and his fellow Reformers were evangelists. God used them to call His people to His Word and to Himself. They knocked down human barriers so that every believer could know the joy of salvation and share that joy with a world in desperate need.

We hope that you are planning to learn more about the roots of the Reformation and the great truths of reformed theology by joining us at our October Reformation Conference. This is a great opportunity to equip yourself for your role as a modern evangelist, a believer who knows what the Scripture teaches and why it matters.
