Big Idea: “There is no blessing as great as God dwelling with his people.”

Application ~ 3 Points

- A way must be opened to us for God to dwell with us.
 - A way has been opened for us in Christ Jesus.
 - A response to his glorious presence must be biblical worship.
1. Have you ever been in the presence of royalty? Fame?
 2. **Heavy:** The Hebrew word for *glory* can also be translated *heavy* or *weight*. Pastor Tom said, “God’s glory tells us that God is not to be taken lightly.” Do you think the church today believes God’s glory to be a weighty thing? Why or why not?
 3. **Compare & Contrast:** What are some differences between someone who recognizes the weightiness of God’s glory vs. someone who thinks of it as a light thing? How might their lives look different?
 4. **Day-to-Day:** “There is no blessing as great as God dwelling with his people, but there is also nothing more intimidating than God’s dwelling with his people.” How does the glory of God effect *your* day-to-day life?
 5. **Evangelism:** Who is someone in your life that needs to hear the Gospel? How might this sermon inform the way you share Christ with them?
